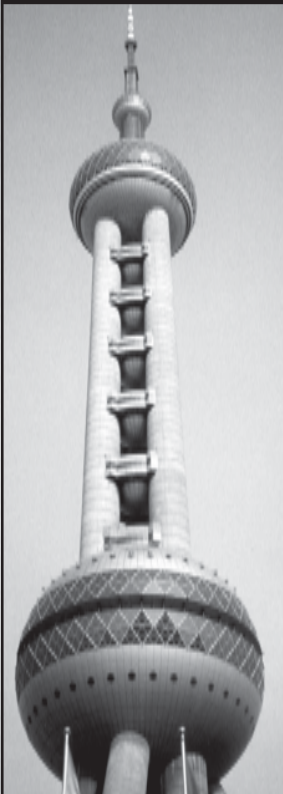

## LANDON-IN-CHINA CULTURAL EXPLORATION AND LANGUAGE IMMERSION

A 6-week co-ed cultural and linguistic program

### **Travel in China will include:**

Highlights of Hong Kong, Guangzhou, Xi'an, Songshan and Beijing

### **Language Immersion in China**

Morning language classes

Individual placement with Chinese host family

Excursions in Beijing and Chengdu

Sight seeing in Shanghai

*Completion of the immersion part of the program grants one year of academic credit in Chinese language.*

The co-educational "Landon-in-China" program is built upon the long relationship between the Landon School and its sister schools in China. **The full program is open to students in Grades 9 through 12** and will take place in two stages from June 28 to August 9. Students may elect to participate in either one or both of the following opportunities. **The travel-only segment is also open to students in Grades 7 and 8.** No prior knowledge of Chinese is required.

### **I. Cultural Tour of China (June 28-July 12, 2009)**

This year's travel component of the Landon-in-China program will begin in Hong Kong where you will see the city from atop Victoria Peak, and enjoy shopping in Stanley Market. Take a bus ride to Guangzhou and white rafting in Dinghu Mountain area. From Guangzhou you will fly to Xi'an to see the Terracotta Soldiers who protect the tomb of the first emperor of China. Then you will fly to Songshan to visit the Shaolin Temple, famous for its martial arts. Next, head for the bustling streets of China's capital, Beijing. Begin your Beijing tour by visiting the most famous landmarks of China, including Tiananmen Square, the Forbidden City and the Great Wall. You will have the special opportunity to visit the venues designed for the 2008 Olympics such as the Bird's Nest and the Water Cube. Fly home from Beijing.

### **II. Language Immersion in Beijing and Chengdu (July 11-August 9, 2009)**

Continue, or begin, your summer in China in Beijing. Live with a Chinese host family in both Beijing and Chengdu, and rapidly expand your language skills. Students can earn a full year's academic credit in Chinese language by completing this language-immersion program, which includes intensive language classes divided by ability levels in the morning and cultural classes in the afternoon. The program also includes weekly sightseeing excursions. Internship opportunities with professors at Chinese universities on a subject of the student's choice will also be available for an additional fee. You'll end your immersion experience in Shanghai.

Your faculty companion in China will be Dr. Dali Tan. Dr. Tan is a Chinese teacher at Landon School in Bethesda, MD. A native of Shenyang, she has led China travel study tours for students from Landon and St. Catherine's School in Richmond, Virginia. She also helped establish the ESL exchange component of the "Landon-in-China" program, which brings Chinese students to the Landon campus for instruction and cultural exchange. She is the president of the Chinese Language Association for Secondary and Elementary Schools and was a member of the AP Chinese course and exam development committee of the College Board.
