



2018–19 Landon School Store Policies

Please take the time to review the following information about purchasing Landon gear and using student charge accounts at Bear Essentials, the Landon School Store.

Gear, School Supplies and Snacks

The Landon School Store carries a wide array of clothing, gear and gifts for all ages, with a focus on the basics that every Landon boy may need for school and sports. We stock T-shirts, shorts, sweats, cold-weather gear, socks, belts, ties and compression undergarments in addition to the “fun stuff.” We have a full selection of school supplies at prices competitive with office superstores. We also offer a variety of wholesome snacks (such as cheese, trail mix and dried fruit), milk, and of course Goldfish crackers and Clif Bars.

Upper School students are permitted to visit and make purchases at the store at any time. **Middle School students** are permitted to visit the store for clothing/supplies/gear purchases at recess, and may also purchase snacks after dismissal at 3:30 p.m. **Lower School students** may make clothing/supplies/gear purchases at recess only, with the permission of their teachers. Purchases in the School Store may be made with cash, check and credit card. Students and their parents may charge to their student accounts as well (see below).

Using Student Charge Accounts

Every student at Landon has the ability to charge purchases at the School Store and Gym Snack Bar to his student account. (The Gym Snack Bar is open from 3:30–4 p.m. and is operated by Landon’s Dining Services Team). These charges are itemized and included on monthly billing statements, along with other incidentals. **Permission to charge at the School Store and Gym Snack Bar will be assumed for all students unless parents or guardians indicate otherwise.** If you would like to prohibit School Store/Gym Snack Bar charges to your student’s account, please email or call Jennifer Reed in the School Store to discuss turning off your student’s account. We do recommend that you leave charge accounts open and instead talk with your student about your expectations and limits, as most boys are able to handle that responsibility quite well. This leaves his account open for emergency needs such as school supplies and sports/P.E. clothing, if you give him permission to make such purchases. That being said, it is quite easy for students to run up large bills at either location when they are not made specifically aware of their spending restrictions or limits, so please speak frankly with your student before the school year begins.
