









# Landon Middle School – FAQs

**School Hours:** 8 a.m.–3:40 p.m. (Classes begin at 8:05 a.m.)

**AfterCare:** All students who remain on campus after 4 p.m. must be supervised. The AfterCare program runs from 4:15–6 p.m.

## Dress Code

<b>Neckties</b> 	All boys wear a fully-tied necktie. Bow ties are permitted.
<b>Jackets</b> 	Students wear a suit coat, sport coat or blazer in good repair.
<b>Footwear</b> 	Shoes and socks must be worn at all times. Shoes must be closed toe, worn properly and in good repair (sandals and slippers are not permitted during the class day). Boots are permitted in rainy, wet or sloppy weather; they are not permitted as regular school dress.
<b>Shirts</b> 	Collared dress shirts are to be worn with all buttons buttoned.
<b>Extra Layers</b> 	Sweaters, vests and polar fleece pullovers, as long as they are free of large endorsements or logos, may be worn over the dress shirt and under the blazer. The only sweatshirts that are permitted are non-hooded Landon ones.
<b>Pants/Shorts</b> 	Dress trousers, suit pants or khaki material trousers are acceptable. During the months of September, May and June, students may wear shorts in lieu of trousers. Shorts are expected to adhere to the same expectations (other than length) as pants. Belts are required at all times.
<b>Outdoor Clothing</b> 	Scarves, coats, hats, etc. are not to be worn indoors. No jacket or fleece pullover of any kind should be worn over the blazer while indoors.
<b>Hair</b> 	Hair should be clean, neat, well groomed, and out of a student's eyes at all times. In keeping with the spirit of the dress code, unconventional hairstyles (such as "Mohawks"), ponytails, and/or unnaturally colored or dyed hair are unacceptable.
