

# Landon Upper School – FAQs

**School Hours:** 8 a.m.–3:15 p.m. (Classes begin at 8:05 a.m.)

## Dress Code

| <b>Neckties</b><br>       | All boys wear a fully-tied necktie. Bow ties are permitted.  |
| <b>Jackets</b><br>        | Boys are required to wear a suit coat, sport coat or blazer (letter jackets can be worn as outer garments only).   |
| <b>Shirts</b><br>         | Students are required to wear a collared dress shirt, long- or short-sleeved, that is tucked in. Students may not wear polo shirts, athletic shirts, shirts that advertise, Hawaiian-style shirts, or short-sleeved shirts over long-sleeved undershirts or jerseys.   |
| <b>Sweaters</b><br>       | Students may wear a sweater over their dress shirt. Sweatshirts and “hoodies” are not permitted to be worn during the school day, 8:05 a.m.–3:15 p.m.  |
| <b>Pants/Shorts</b><br> | Students are required to wear pants with cuffed or hemmed pant legs, and may not wear jeans, military, athletic or cargo pants. If pants have belt loops, a belt must be worn. During the months of September, May and June, students may wear shorts in lieu of trousers. Shorts are expected to adhere to the same expectations (other than length) as pants.  |
| <b>Footwear</b><br>     | Students are required to wear socks that cover the ankle and casual or dress shoes that lace up or slip on (including loafers, boat shoes and low-top walking shoes), and may not wear sneakers, athletic shoes or boots. A student may wear shoes that do not conform to Landon’s dress code only if supported by a physician’s written recommendation. Boots may be worn on days when there is a weather-related late opening. |
| <b>Hair</b><br>         | Facial hair (beards, mustaches, goatees and long sideburns) is not permitted, and hair should be kept at a reasonable length. In keeping with the spirit of the dress code, unconventional hairstyles (such as “Mohawks”), ponytails, and/or unnaturally colored or dyed hair are unacceptable.  |
